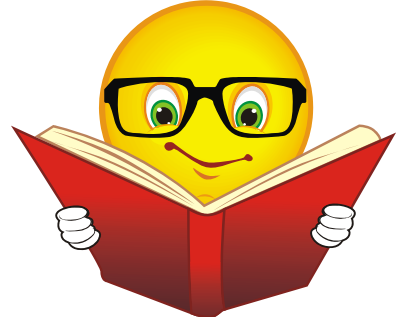


# **READING ROCKS!**
