



## New and Exciting Changes for 2009-2010

It is our desire to continue to minister to all families that feel called to enroll their children at Crossroads. We have made the following changes to our fees for next year:

- Pre-K fees will be \$3800.00 (\$3000 tuition, \$250 enrollment, \$250 book fee, \$300 resource fee)
- Kindergarten fees will be \$4800.00 (\$4000 tuition, \$250 enrollment, \$250 book fee, \$300 resource fee)
- 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade fees will be \$5800.00 (\$5000 tuition, \$250 enrollment, \$250 book fee, \$300 resource fee)

Please note for next year you may include the \$300 resource fee in your FACTS payment plan. The enrollment/re-enrollment fee of \$250 is still due upon enrollment and the \$250 book fee is still due on or before July 1<sup>st</sup>.

We are also offering a sibling discount of 50% off the tuition for the youngest children of families who have three or more children. For example, a family of five children would pay full tuition for the two oldest children and receive 50% off tuition for the next three children. Please note that this does not apply to pastors or teachers.

Next year we are planning to run three bus routes both to and from school to help parents with transportation costs. The routes will serve the Creedmoor/Oxford area, the Wake Forest/Youngsville area and the Bracey/Norlina area. The cost per student for a year of bus transportation is \$673. For 180 days of school this breaks down to \$3.74 a day. This cost may also be deducted from FACTS with the tuition. Once you have signed up, please remember that this is a yearly cost and your child will be charged whether they are on the bus or not.
